ASHRAE joint meeting with CSI
“Master Spec Format Changes”

He is Chairman of the CSI/CSC MasterFormat Expansion Task Team, a North American effort to expand the industry standard for organizing specifications. He also serves on the OmniClass Construction Classification System (OCCS) Development Committee.

He will cover such questions as:

- What is MasterFormat and why is it being changed?
- What does MasterFormat have to do with trade jurisdiction?
- What is the MasterFormat expansion process schedule?

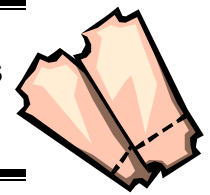
